There a quite a few restrictions that will apply to this hunt. **DRAW DATE**: To be fair, every kid who registers for the hunt will be put into a drawing and we will be drawing from a random raffle on November 1st. **Only 8 participants will be drawn**. Youth participants will have to pay for the hunt and have their tag applied for by November 10, 2020 or another youth participants' name will be drawn.

Each youth participant will have to provide a **School Report Card** showing that he is passing all classes and will have to be prepared to take 3 days off from school.

Agenda: We will be leaving San Antonio at 6am, Thursday morning on December 9th. We should arrive at the ranch by 7pm that evening and will hunt Friday thru Saturday, leaving to head back on Sunday, December 13th arriving back in San Antonio by 8pm.
